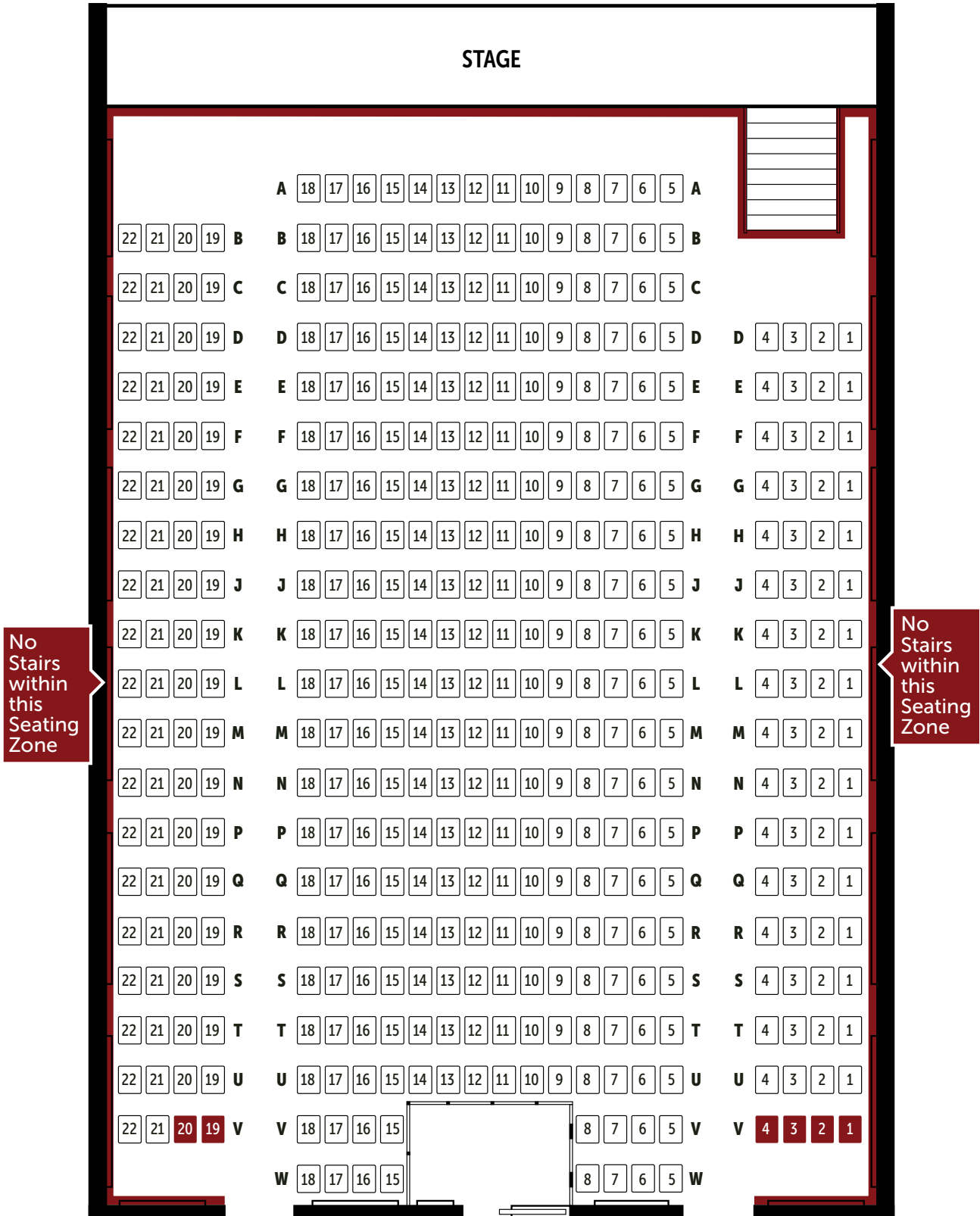

ORCHESTRA SEATING MAP

This map shows the layout of rows, seats, aisles, entrances and Access Seating locations on the Orchestra level, CAA Theatre auditorium

There are no stairs on this level; all seats are within the accessible seating zone containing no stairs.

SEATING ZONE WITH NO STAIRS

There are no stairs and no handrails; there is a gradual slope to the floor. Entrances are located at the rear of the auditorium to the left and right of the centre section behind Row W.

Rows B to V (Left section)

Seats 22 to 19. Right aisle access only, seat 19

Rows A to U (Centre section)

Seats 18 to 5. Left aisle access, seat 18. Right aisle access, seat 5

Rows V to W (Centre section)

Seats 18 to 15. Left aisle access only, seat 18

Rows V to W (Centre section)

Seats 8 to 5. Right aisle access only, seat 5

Rows D to V (Right section)

Seats 4 to 1. Left aisle access only, seat 4

ACCESS SEATING: Wheelchair accessible, Special Access

Row V (Left section)

Seats 20 to 19

Row V (Right section)

Seats 4 to 1

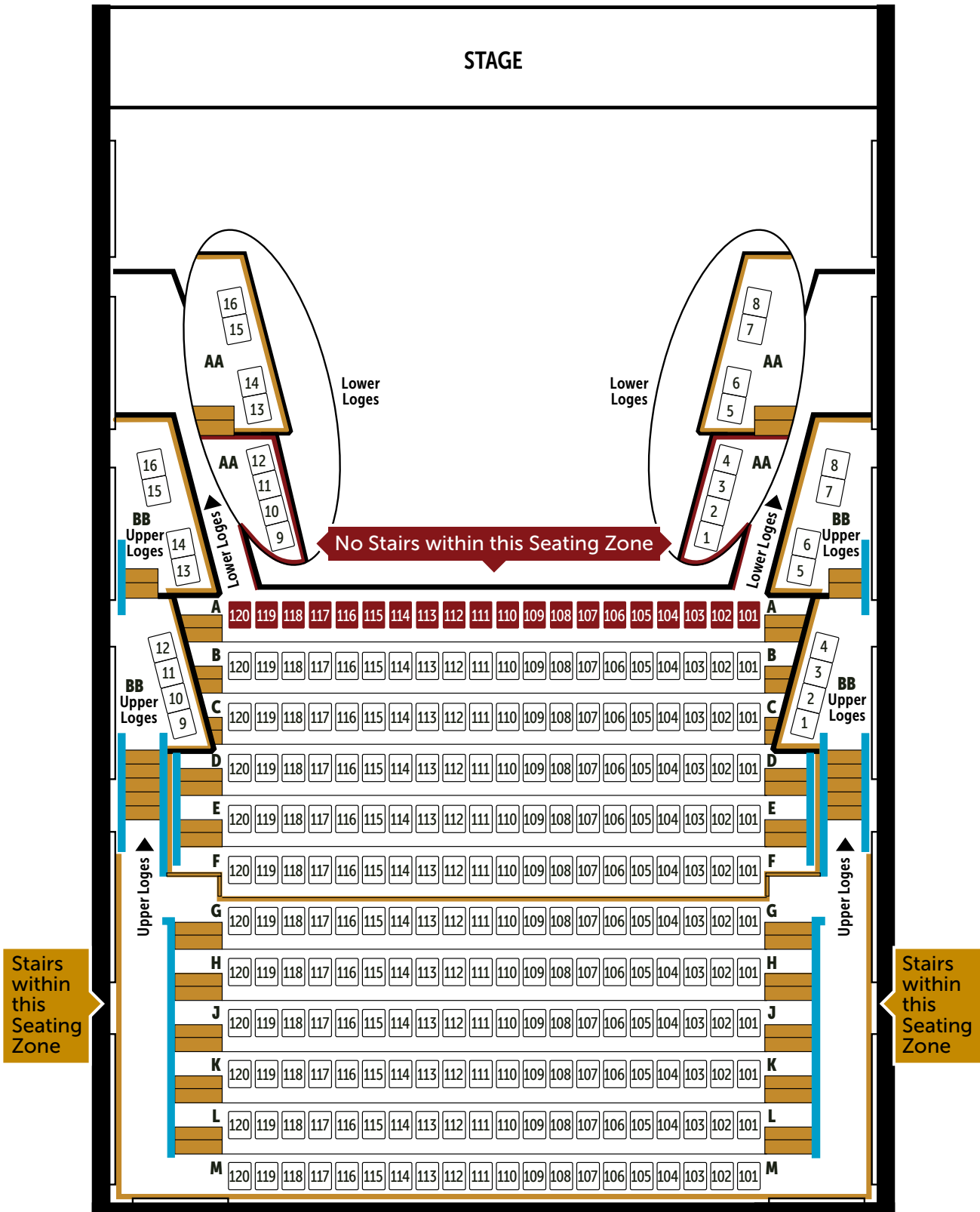
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Wheelchair accessible seating accommodates guests who will remain in a wheelchair or mobility device during the performance, with adjacent seating for one companion guest. **Special Access seating** includes options for bariatric seating (up to 400 pounds) and non-fixed chair seating.

Seating maps are subject to change. Additional restrictions may apply.

BALCONY SEATING MAP

This map shows the layout of rows, seats, aisles, entrances, handrails and Access Seating locations on the Balcony level (Lower and Upper), CAA Theatre auditorium.

The map is divided into seating zones containing stairs, and accessible seating zones containing no stairs.

SEATING ZONE WITH NO STAIRS

The entrance to the Lower Balcony is a ramp with handrails. Guests may access the following seats without use of stairs. Elevator service to the Lower Balcony is available.

These seats are accessible without the use of stairs, however they are not designated as Wheelchair accessible seating or Special Access seating. See ADDITIONAL INFORMATION section for definition of Wheelchair accessible seating and Special Access seating.

Row A (Lower Balcony)

Seats 120 to 101. Left aisle access, seat 120.
Right aisle access, seat 101

Lower Loges AA

Seats 9 to 12 (house left), seats 1 to 4 (house right). These seats are fixed chairs.

SEATING ZONE WITH STAIRS

Rows B to F (Lower Balcony)

Seats 120 to 101. Left aisle access, seat 120.
Right aisle access, seat 101

This zone contains 15 stairs (3 per row) with handrails on the left and right side aisles. There are no centre aisles. Entrances are located on the left and right side of the auditorium, next to Row A. These entrances are ramps with handrails that are accessed from the Lower Balcony Lobby.

Lower Loges AA (Lower Balcony)

Seats 13 to 16 (house left), seats 5 to 8 (house right)

The Loges are located on the left and right side of the auditorium, below Row A at the bottom of the entrance ramps. There are 3 stairs down, with handrails. The seats are fixed chairs.

Row G to M (Upper Balcony)

Seats 120 to 101. Left aisle access, seat 120.
Right aisle access, seat 101

This zone contains 15 stairs (3 per row, Rows H to M) with handrails on the left and right side aisles. There are no centre aisles. Entrances are located on the left and right side of the auditorium, next to Row G. These entrances are ramps with handrails that are accessed from the main staircases on the north and south side of the building. There is no lobby on the Upper Balcony, and no elevator service up to this seating section.

Upper Loges BB (Upper Balcony)

Seats 9 to 12 and 13 to 16 (house left),
seats 1 to 4 and 5 to 8 (house right)

The Loges are located on the left and right side of the auditorium, beyond Row G at the end of the entrance ramps. There are 6 stairs up with handrails to access seats 9 to 12 and seats 1 to 4, and an additional 3 stairs down with handrails to access seats 13 to 16 and seats 5 to 8. These seats are fixed chairs.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Wheelchair accessible seating accommodates guests who will remain in a wheelchair or mobility device during the performance, with adjacent seating for one companion guest. **Special Access seating** includes options for bariatric seating (up to 400 pounds) and non-fixed chair seating.
